Want to get involved in gardening? There are many ways to begin growing your own fruits and vegetables in community and private gardens. This fact sheet provides links for many of the resources to help you get started.



1. Start your own Community Garden

Vancouver's community gardens are very popular and usually fully subscribed early each season. Why not join the City's 2010 Challenge, and start your own?¹ SPEC can also help, with its **"Growing Gardens, a resource package on how to start a community garden"** which can be found on our website or purchased for \$20 in our building. The Kit tells you everything you need to know about starting a new garden. The Vancouver Food Policy Council also maintains a website with links to many helpful resources.²
